- Possible Wesley Seminary Speaker




Itinerary - Israel

- Fri (Oct 25) Caesarea, Megiddo, Nazareth
 Village
- Sat (Oct 26) Galilee, Church of Fish and Loaves, Capernaum, Mount of Beatitudes
- Sun (Oct 27) Upper Galilee, Tel Dan,
 Nimrod's Castle, Sea of Galilee sailing boat
- Mon (Oct 28) Jordan Valley, Qumran,
 Masada, Mount Scopus

Itinerary – Israel (cont'd)

- Tues (Oct 29) Christian Jerusalem, Garden of Gethsemane, Upper Room, Caiaphas' House, Davidson Center and Southern Wall Excavations, optional Citadel Sound and Light Show
- Wed (Oct 30) Jerusalem, Via Dolorosa, St. Anne's Church, Eye of Needle, Antonia Fortress, Church of Holy Sepulchre, Garden Tomb

Itinerary – Jordan Extension

- Fri (Nov 1) Cross into Jordan, Jordan Baptismal site, Mt. Nebo, Madaba, overnight Dead Sea hotel
- Sat (Nov 2) Tour Petra, overnight Dead Sea hotel
- Sun (Nov 3) Karak Castle, Nature Preserve, Free time at hotel, Dead Sea float
- Mon (Nov 4) Tour Jerash, drive to Amman for dinner and overnight
- Tue (Nov 5) Return to USA from Amman

Health & Fitness Considerations

 EO Fit To Travel Statement: Passengers registering for the tour accept responsibility for being in good health and able to walk and travel on the tour. Many of the sites are physically challenging, those needing wheelchairs, oxygen, or other ambulatory assistance will find the tour extremely limiting in their experiences. Trip Costs

- Trip Includes: Airfare, Taxes and Fees, Tips, Hotels, Buffet Breakfast and Dinner, Guides, Buses, Drivers, Entrance Fees
- Not Included: Love Offering for Driver and Guide, Lunches, optional trip insurance and Sound and Light Show tickets (and possibly the Bethlehem excursion)
- Israel with Air: \$3,796 from Washington Dulles per person, double occupancy (Single rooms are available for an additional \$748)
- Jordan with Air: \$1168 from Washington Dulles per person, double occupancy (Single rooms are available for an additional \$398)
- If the tour totals are less than 30 passengers, the selling price could increase depending on the final number

Trip Payments

- At Registration: \$100 deposit prior to 12/23/18, \$300 deposit prior to 4/22/19 (can be cash or credit)
- Second payment: \$1,200 due by Jul 10, 2019
- Full/Final Payment: due no later than Aug 9, 2019
- Please note: price reflects a 4% cash discount for full payment via check
- Cancellation fees: prior to July 10th \$100, after July 10th fees increase
