A Parent's Blessing

- 1. Context of Blessings
 - a. Just as a pastor has the opportunity to bless their congregation, parents have a similar privilege.
 - b. Old Testament blessings were often physical such as God blessing the Israelites with manna or blessing Elizabeth with a baby
 - c. New Testament blessings were often spiritual and eternal such as in the Beatitudes: "they will be comforted" or "theirs is the kingdom of heaven".
- 2. What is a Blessing?
 - a. A tangible form of God's favor and goodness. "To bless" is to declare the truth of God's good desires for others over someone. For example, "May God bless you with..."
 - b. People were convinced that once a blessing was given, the speaker could not take it back.
 - i. Isaac's blessing mistakenly given to his younger son, Jacob, rather than to his firstborn, Esau (Ge. 27:1-40)
 - ii. Once Isaac spoke the words there was nothing he could do to take back the blessing, even though Jacob had used deceit to get it.
- 3. The benefits of blessing our children
 - a. It is an opportunity for us to express our prayers and desire for God's goodness to be experienced in our children's lives.
 - b. It can show our children the heart of God, e.g. His desire to prosper them, not to harm them, to be with them always, to comfort and lead them, etc.
 - c. This blessing can serve as a reminder for the family of the relationship that has been built, especially in difficult times
 - d. Blessings provide a sense of security, love, and commitment.
 - e. We fulfill God's call for us to bless others and to be a blessing, especially towards our family

How to Write a Blessing for Your Child

- Pray and ask the Lord to show you how your child needs to be blessed. Areas of need can include friendships, direction, wisdom, growth, compassion and much more. Make it unique to them!
- Consider your child's specific traits and talents
- Give words of love and acceptance
 - John, God loves you and chooses you. We love you and are proud of you. We are so glad and thankful to be your parents and to have you as our son.
- Show your child how much you value him or her
 - Jennifer, you show incredible maturity in your love of God. You give us reasons to trust you in your decision-making. When you see the need for forgiveness, you practice seeking it or offering it. You are a Godly, intelligent, and kind young woman.
- Acknowledge God's presence in their future
 - Margaret, you have already shown how God is at work in you. You have an incredible future. We bless you to live a life bringing people who have struggled with peace so that they may receive it from God.
- Genuine Commitment
 - Peter, as you grow into a Godly man we will pray for your daily, encourage you to excellence, celebrate you in success and comfort you in struggles. You are our son and we will always be your proud and loving parents. May God, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, bless you.

Sample Blessings

Heavenly Father, in the name of your Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, **bless Shawn with your peace**, which passes, that is, excels above and is superior to, all understanding, all human intellect.
